Subject: Action Taken Report Called for(ATR) -451/12/8/2026.

Sir/ Madam,

The complaint/ intimation dated 21/01/2026, was placed before the Commission on 02/03/2026. Upon perusing the same, the Commission directed as follows:

Notice under Section 12 of the PHR Act,1993

The Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993, has entrusted the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC), India, with the responsibility of protecting and promoting the rights of all human beings in the country and having the powers of a civil court for inquiry u/s 13 of the PHR Act, 1993.

The complainant alleged that **[REDACTED]**, an assistant professor at AIIMS Bhopal, MP died on 5th January, 2026, due to severe mental harassment and a toxic work culture created

by Dr. Mohammad Yunus, HOD, Trauma and Emergency Medicine, AIIMS Bhopal. The complainant further alleged that despite sending three emails regarding her distress, the administration took no action. The complainant also alleged that the institutional negligence, as no FIR has been registered and previous complaints by other female doctors were suppressed. The complainant sought the intervention of the Commission in the matter and has requested a high-level independent inquiry into the death of Dr. [REDACTED], accountability of Dr. Yunus in the matter, registration of FIR in this human rights violation.

The allegations made in the complaint prima facie seem to be violations of the human rights of the victim.

The Bench of the National Human Rights Commission, presided by Shri Priyank Kanoongo, Hon'ble Member, has taken cognizance u/s 12 of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993, in the matter. The Registry is directed to issue a notice to the Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi, with directions to get the allegations made in the complaint inquired into.

The Commissioner of Police, Bhopal and the Director, AIIMS, Bhopal with directions to get the allegations made in the complaint inquired into and furnish the copies of FIR, PM report and other relevant documents in the matter. They are also directed to provide the details of POSH Committee including the criteria for being the Member of the Committee, statements of Committee Members, activities of last 3 years performed by the committee. Further provide copies of complaint received in last three years, including complaints filed by the victim and action taken on all complaints and copies of all statement of former employees/doctors, as mentioned by the complainant.

Submit an Action Taken Report within In 15 days for perusal of the Commission. A copy of the complaint is attached herewith.

The authority is also directed that a copy of the report in the matter be also sent on e-mail: bench-mpk@gov.in

2. Accordingly, I am forwarding herewith a copy of the complaint/ intimation as an attachment for taking appropriate action in the matter as per the directions of the Commission. It is requested that an Action Taken Report be sent to the Commission within 0 weeks from the date of receipt of this letter.
