Subject: Opening of Bank Account Re-confirmation/Correction Window for Refund of NEET (UG) 2026 Examination Fee (Examination held on 03 May 2026) – OTP-Based Two-Factor Authentication Mandatory

1. As candidates are aware, the National Testing Agency (NTA) is processing the refund of examination fee for NEET (UG) 2026. For this purpose, candidates were earlier provided an opportunity to furnish their bank account details through the registration portal.
2. During scrutiny of the bank account details received, it has been observed that some candidates have furnished incomplete or incorrect particulars, including invalid account numbers and other discrepancies. NTA has also received representations from candidates seeking an opportunity to verify and rectify their bank account details to facilitate successful credit of the refund amount.
3. Accordingly, in the interest of candidates and to ensure that the refund amount reaches the correct beneficiary, NTA has decided to open a Bank Account Re-confirmation/Correction Window.
4. As an additional security measure and to protect candidates' account information, access to the facility shall be permitted only after completion of OTP-based Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) through the candidate's registered mobile number. Only upon successful authentication shall the candidate be allowed to view, verify, update, or confirm the bank account details.
5. Candidates are advised to:
 - (a) Log in to the NEET (UG) 2026 portal using their Application Number and Password and complete the OTP-based authentication through the registered mobile number;
 - (b) Carefully verify and furnish the following details:
 - Beneficiary Name;
 - Bank Account Number;
 - Re-enter/Confirm Bank Account Number;
 - Bank Name;
 - IFSC Code;

- (c) Optionally upload a scanned copy of a cancelled cheque or the first page of the bank passbook containing the account details, wherever available;
- (d) Ensure that all particulars furnished are correct and belong to the intended beneficiary account for receipt of the refund;
- (e) Keep their login credentials, OTP, and personal information confidential and not share the same with any person under any circumstances.
6. The update of the Bank Account details should be done before downloading the Admit Card for NEET (UG) 2026.
