PRESS RELEASE

At the Annual Meeting of the Governing Body of the Consortium of National Law Universities held on 18 July 2026, the following resolutions were adopted regarding the CLAT Expert Committee Report 2026:

1. **CLAT 2027:** The Governing Body resolved that there will be **no changes to the syllabus and pattern/sections** of the UG and PG papers in CLAT 2027. The Convenor CLAT 2027 and all paper setters will consider and adopt the suggestions of the CLAT Expert Committee Report regarding question format and quality in a feasible manner.
2. **Publication of the CLAT Expert Committee Report:** The Report shall be published on the website of the Consortium to invite feedback and suggestions from experts, students and the wider public. The Report is (available [here](#)) and feedback may be shared by filling in the form (available [here](#)) by August 31, 2026.
3. **Further Discussion and Next Steps:** On 17 May 2026, at a meeting convened by the President of the Consortium of NLUs at the National Judicial Academy, Bhopal it was resolved that the Office of the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India shall constitute a Committee for further consideration of the recommendations of the Report. The Governing Body of the Consortium of NLUs shall, in coordination with the Committee, engage with the recommendations of the Report and public feedback in preparation for CLAT 2028.
